



FAMILY SUCCESS CENTER

The VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) tax prep-program launched on February 1, 2021 at the Bayside Family Success Center. The Bayside FSC, along with the entire JRF Community & Family Services staff and volunteers, worked hard to develop a process to keep everyone involved in this initiative safe. The Bayside FSC took the lead and has been in continuous communication with our collaborating partner, United Way, to ensure a smooth process for each tax filer. Intakes are completed by telephone and an appointment is scheduled for the tax filer to drop off their documents safely, in a secure drop box at the Bayside FSC.

The Bayside FSC was also able to host a great parent child activity to commemorate Valentine's Day. Activities like "Hot Chocolate & Paint" as well as "Baking with Grandma" were offered to families virtually via Zoom. The Bayside FSC staff created and carefully distributed activity kits to support the families.

The month of February included strong collaborations for the PAAC Small Business team, as we provided COVID relief materials for our PAAC Small businesses and provided consultation for grants. Hand sanitizers, facemasks, window clings and reusable bags were distributed amongst several businesses in the fight against COVID. The PAAC small business team also made it a priority to assist our small businesses with valuable financial information. This focused commitment by our team led to two of our neighborhood businesses securing an award from the Middlesex County Small Business Relief Grant one for a \$24,000 grant and another for an
